Registration for the Third Annual Medical-dental Integration (MDI) Symposium is now open. The free virtual symposium, which is co-sponsored by USAble Life, is scheduled for Sept. 13, 1–5 p.m. CDT. This year's theme is Interoperability and Clinical Information Sharing to Improve Health Care Outcomes.
